WRITE OUT LOUD! AN AUTHOR'S JOURNEY FROM IDEA TO PUBLISHED BOOK

Our Feathered Friends - An Introduction to Bird Watching



She is an avid bird watcher, author of <u>Backyard Birds</u>, long-standing member of The North Shore Audubon Society, and a former advisory board member of the Theodore Roosevelt Sanctuary and Audubon Center. She covers the basics of what constitutes a bird and which birds you could expect to see in your backyard. She offers information on what you can do to attract birds and how to identify their differences. This program concludes with a bird walk.

With a journal and pen, you are invited to explore your creative side and expand your knowledge of writing.
